

The SAPIA logo is a mark of distinction, a guarantee of quality, as members must meet admission criteria and abide by the standards embodied in the Association's Code of Ethics and the Constitution. PROMOTION -

WEBSITE PROFILE -

TENDER NOTIFICATION SERVICE -

Members are kept up to date with the latest tender releases on a daily basis, saving them potentially thousands of dollars annually.

SAPIA works closely with sports and recreation, as well as construction bodies. These authorities actively support SAPIA and recommend SAPIA members for sports and recreation projects.
