The program recognises the work of its members who are participating in achieving this goal, and provides members with the opportunity to celebrate their work. The Awards Presentation is a highlight of our Annual Dinner. We encourage all members to nominate their projects or products for our Awards competition.

SPORTS AWARDS

- S1. Construction – Commercial Sports Court/s
- S2. Construction – Domestic Sports Court/s (above \$100,000)
- S3. Construction – Domestic Sports Court/s (below \$100,000)
- S4. Construction - Sports Facilities
- S5. Surfacing – Outdoor Sports Facilities
- Surfacing Indoor Sports Facilities S6.
- S7. Sports Equipment Installations

PLAY AWARDS

- P1. Surfacing – Regional Play Space
- P2. Surfacing - Council/School Play Space
- P3. Surfacing - Childcare/Early Learning Centre/Preschool Play Space

INNOVATION AWARD

Innovation Award – Any Product or Service 1

In order to provide the opportunity for all members of the Association to participate in the Industry Awards, the above categories were designed to enable suppliers and service members, as well as builders, to enter their work for recognition. Evaluation criteria may include the following:

- layout/design
- site work/drainage
- base construction, surface adequacy and aesthetics
- floodlighting if applicable
- fencing if applicable, and
- overall impression of the finished project.

The project scoring the highest number of points is adjudged the winner of that category.



RULES

- Any financial member of the Sports And Play Industry Association is eligible to enter.
- Projects submitted must have been completed within the last 3 years as at 30 June 2017, and must not previously have won a SAPIA or Sports Contractors Association Industry Award.

HOW TO PROCEED

There are two forms to be completed per entry:

- 1. Form One: Nomination Form. This form should list full details of entrant and any other contractors involved in the project, if
 - applicable. This form is retained by the SAPIA Secretary so that the project entry form passed to the judges has no identifying marks as to contractors or facility locations.
- 2. Form Two: Project Entry Form. This form is provided to the judges. Attach plans/drawings if applicable (with no identifying marks as to builders, suppliers or location), and photographs.
- 3. Submitting entries:
 - Hard copy: mail 2 copies of documents and photographs to PO Box 118 Mona Vale NSW 1660. USB Drive: mail 1 copy of documents and photographs to PO Box 118 Mona Vale NSW 1660. Email or Dropbox: 1 copy of documents and photographs to: office@sapia.org.au
- 4. The entrant must be the owner of the photographs, information and drawings submitted with the entry, and by entering this Award competition authorises the Sports And Play Industry Association to release any of these materials, to reproduce them in publications, news releases and other materials, including those not pertaining to the Awards program, without compensation.
- 5. The administration fee for each entry is \$60.00. Payment can be made by cheque or bank transfer. Cheques should be mailed to: Sports And Play Industry Association Limited, PO Box 118, Mona Vale NSW 1660. SAPIA's bank account is: BSB 013 457; Account No. 4406 74957.
- 6. Forward completed applications to be received no later than 14 July 2017. Entries received after this date will be excluded from the judging for this year.
