

VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

Royal On The Park Hotel & Suites is one of Brisbane's Most Iconic Hotels

Royal on the Park Hotel & Suites has maintained its history and elegance from its inception in the 1960s through its refurbishment in recent years. The polished walnut wood panelling, crystal chandeliers, antiques and traditional service have played host to celebrities and rock stars. Boasting a city centre location in the heart of the Brisbane CBD, Royal on the Park is a 4.5 star venue offering stylish, comfortable accommodation. Choose from 153 deluxe rooms and a collection of suites, each of which offers classically elegant ambience and luxury amenities. Accommodation ranges from rooms with one King or two Queen beds, to spacious inter-connecting family rooms, as well as Junior, Spa and Executive Suites with separate master bedrooms and living areas. The hotel is located across the road from the Botanic Gardens and is a stone's throw from the Brisbane River, with easy access to many major Brisbane attractions including South Bank Parklands, Gallery of Modern Art, Queensland Art Gallery and Queensland Performing Arts Centre.



The hotel's Park View Rooms look out over the Botanic Gardens and offer guests a tranquil retreat in the heart of Brisbane. Rates start at \$201 per room for Deluxe City View rooms, \$218 for Deluxe Park View Rooms, which includes a 15% discount off their Best Available Rate for SAPIA Conference Delegates. To book your room, go to www.royalonthepark.com.au/rooms-suites, enter your dates, use the PromoCode **SPORTS** then click the 'make a reservation' box, then choose your room type. I would encourage you to book your accommodation early, cancellations can be made up to 6 p.m. the day prior to arrival.



Breakfast is served in the hotel's Walnut Restaurant for \$27.50 (continental) and \$35 (full buffet) for in-house guests and visitors.

Car parking is available at a discounted rate of \$30 per vehicle per day. All overnight car parking is charged at \$35 per vehicle per 24 hours. Valet parking is \$45 per vehicle.

Getting there from Brisbane Airport:

The Royal On The Park is situated at 152 Alice Street, Brisbane City and is an easy 20 minute drive from Brisbane Airport along Airport Link Road.

Taxi - There is a taxi rank at the airport and outside the front of the hotel, costs can be between \$45.00 and \$65.00 depending on traffic.

ConXion Shuttle - can be booked at the airport or through their website <u>www.con-x-ion.com</u>. It costs approximately \$20.00 per adult for a one-way trip and will drop you directly outside of the hotel reception.

Priority One Shuttle Service – a personal and very reliable service with \$55.00 flat rate from the Airport to the Hotel or \$45.00 from the Hotel to either terminal at the Airport. Bookable on their website www.traveltogueensland.com

Air Train - The Airtrain connects both the Domestic Airport and the International Airport with the inner city stations. One-way tickets are approx. \$19 per adult each way. We recommend disembarking from Central station, which is then a 10-15 minute walk of 4-5 city blocks.


