#### **From Sydney**

Cypress Lakes is 1 hour 40 minutes drive north from Wahroonga. Take the Pacific Motorway/M1 north towards Newcastle. Take the Freemans Drive/B82 exit (signs to Kurri Kurri/Cessnock), then follow your GPS to Cypress Lakes Resort at 15 Thompsons Road, Pokolbin. Alternatively, take the Hunter Expressway/M15 towards Singleton and follow your GPS.

#### **From Interstate**

Direct flights are available to Newcastle (NSW) Airport from Melbourne, Brisbane and Adelaide. Flights from other locations require a stop in either Sydney or Brisbane.

#### **From Newcastle Airport**

All major car rental firms operate from Newcastle airport. The resort is 70km or one hour's drive from the airport.
